Azerbaijan → Georgia

Following ancient caravan routes

The Great Silk Road was stretched from the Caspian Sea to the Black Sea coast. Once upon a time ancient caravans passed here, carrying delicate jewels, precious stones and spices. Today the Great Silk Road sites can be visited while travelling in the South Caucasus.

Day 1: Arrival in Baku;

(driving distance ≈ 20km/driving time ≈ 0,5 hours)
Met and assisted at the airport. Transfer to the hotel*;
Overnight in Baku.

Day 2: Baku Old City & Absheron Peninsula tour;

(driving distance ≈ 90 km/driving time ≈ 2,5 hours)
Explore old town of Baku, called Ichari Shahr which is also a fortress. In the afternoon proceed to Absheron peninsula.
The wide plain of Absheron with ravines and salt lakes, vineyards and tea plantations is particularly noted for its oil deposits.

- Pick up guests from different hotels;
 - 9:00 - Baku City Tour. Visit: Shirvanshah's Palace, Maiden Tower, Ateshgah, Carpet Museum;
 - 13:00 - Free time for lunch*;
 - Explore Absheron Peninsula: visit the burning mountain Yanar Dag, Mardakan castle, Ramana castle;
 - Drop off guests to different hotels;
- Overnight in Baku.

Day 3: Baku-Gobustan-Shamakhi-Sheki;

(driving distance ≈ 430 km/driving time ≈ 6 hours)
Visit Gobustan Rock Art Cultural landscape representing an outstanding collection of over 7000 rock engravings and drive to Sheki. En route visit historical and religious sites of Shemakhi.

- Pick up guests from different hotels;
 - 9:00 - Drive to Gobustan to visit Gobustan National Park;
 - Explore the Town Shemakhi and Diribaba mausoleum;
 - 13:00 - Free time for lunch*;
 - Visit Juma-Mosque (Friday Mosque) of Shamakhi; Seven Domes - the complex of tombs built for Shirvan's royal family in 18 th c.
 - Drive to Sheki; evening walk in Sheki;
- Overnight in Sheki.

Day 4: Sheki- Lagodekhi Border-Tbilisi;

(driving distance ≈ 340 km/driving time ≈ 6 hours)
Enjoy Sheki sightseeing tour and drive to Georgian. After border crossing continue sightseeing in Georgia.

- 9:00 - Visit Sheki Khan's Palace;
 - Drive to Lagodekhi border. Cross border and continue sightseeing;
 - 14:00 - Free time for lunch*;
 - Visit Nekresi Architectural Complex;
 - Short stop in historical centre of Telavi and drive to Tbilisi;
 - Drop off guests to different hotels;
- Overnight in Tbilisi.

Day 5: Half Day Tbilisi City Tour;

(driving distance ≈ 50km/driving time ≈ 1 hour)

Visit Tbilisi, a town which conquers you with increasing fascination and lodges in your heart forever.

- Pick up guests from different hotels;
- 10:00 – Tbilisi sightseeing tour. Sights to visit: Old City, Metekhi Church, Narikala Fortress, Abanotubani – Sulphur bath district, Sioni Cathedral, Anchiskhati Basilica, Rustaveli Avenue;
- 13:00 – Free time for lunch*;
- Free time. Suggested places to visit: National Museum of Georgia*, Open Air Ethnographic Museum*;
- 20:00 – Welcome dinner at a local restaurant with traditional folk show.

Drop off guests to different hotels;

Overnight in Tbilisi.

Day 6: Round trip to Wine Region - Kakheti;

(driving distance ≈ 330 km/driving time ≈ 4 hours)

Kakheti region is well-known for its hardworking, good-tempered people, and mostly for its wines. Ancient Georgian traditional Qvevri winemaking is listed in Intangible Cultural Heritage Monuments by UNESCO.

- Pick up guests from different hotels;
- 9:00 – Drive to Kakheti region; visit: Bodbe Nunnery, Signaghi - City of Love;
- 13:00 – Free time for lunch*;
- Wine tasting at a local winery;
- Drop off guests to different hotels;

Overnight in Tbilisi.

Day 7: From Tbilisi to Khevi Province;

(driving distance ≈ 315 km/driving time ≈ 4,5 hours)

In order to see the high peaks, roaring rivers and mountain lifestyle of Georgia's northern borderlands travel to Stepantsminda via Mtskheta (UNESCO site) - former capital, historical and religious center of country.

- Pick up guests from different hotels;
- 9:00 – Drive to Mtskheta. Sights to visit: Jvari Monastery, Svetitskhoveli Cathedral;
- 13:00 – Free time for lunch*;
- Walk to visit Gergeti Trinity Church- apps. 3hrs. round walk (or by 4WD vehicle*);
- Drop off guests to different hotels;
- 20:00 – Dinner at the hotel;

Overnight in Gudauri.

Day 8: Trip to the oldest urban settlement in Georgia;

(driving distance ≈ 340 km/driving time ≈ 5,5 hours)

From Gudauri highlands drive to Imereti region and visit Kutaisi, the second biggest city of the country.

- Pick up guests from different hotels;
- 9:00 – Drive to visit Ananuri architectural complex;
- Explore Uplistsikhe cave town (dating back to 1 st millennium BC);
- 13:00 – Free time for lunch*;
- Visit Stalin's Museum and the house, where Stalin, the leader of Soviet Union, was born;
- Evening walking tour in Kutaisi;

Overnight in Kutaisi.

Day 9: Trip to the Black Sea Coast

(driving distance ≈ 175 km/driving time ≈ 2,5 hours)

Explore Kutaisi, the ancient capital of the Kingdom of Colchis. In the afternoon drive to Batumi, one of the oldest cities inhabited from as

early as the third century BC.

- 9:00 – Visit Gelati Monastery - the UNESCO site. Drive to Batumi
- 13:00 – Free time for lunch;
- Explore Batumi, one of the most beautiful cities of the Black Sea coastline.
- Drop off guests to different hotels.

Overnight in Batumi.

Day 10: Free day to explore Batumi Independently;

(driving distance ≈ 0 km/driving time ≈ 0 hours)

Guide service and transportation on this day isn't provided.

Optional: Day trip to visit Gonio fortress and Batumi botanical garden*.

Overnight in Batumi.

Day 11: Departure from Batumi;

(driving distance ≈ 20km/driving time ≈ 0,5 hours)

Transfer to airport.*

Not included services - All services mentioned in the Itineraries, but marked with () are provided on supplementary basis - can be purchased on spot or booked in advance upon request.

Notes:

- Airport transfers (if booked) will be arranged to different hotel options chosen by customer.

- Every sightseeing day will start with collecting group members accommodated at different hotel options; the sightseeing day ends with transfer guests back to their hotels.

Flights - Direct flights to Tbilisi, Yerevan, Baku also Kutaisi and Batumi are available from the main European and Asian cities. Flights are operated by: Lufthansa, Turkish Airlines, Qatar Airways, Air France, Condor, LOT, Air Baltic, Wizz Air, FlyDubai, Eurowings, Pegasus, Air Arabia, many more.., and of course Georgian, Armenian and Azerbaijani national carriers.

Visa is not required for Georgia for the citizens of the USA, Canada, Brazil, Argentina, Japan, Israel, Turkey, citizens of EU member countries and CIS - full list is available on www.mfa.gov.ge. Those, who require visa for Georgia will be able to obtain e-visa through www.evisa.gov.ge.

Please find information about visa requirements in Armenia on www.mfa.am. Visa can be obtained at Armenian border upon arrival. The citizens of some countries need invitation letter in order to get visa at the consulate of Armenia in their country of residence. The list of the countries can be found on www.mfa.am.

Visa for Azerbaijan has to be arranged before arrival. You can find information about visa requirements on www.mfa.gov.az. Please note, that e-visa for Azerbaijan can be provided by Caucasus Travel and on supplementary basis.

Passport must be valid for at least six months (required for all three countries).
